## **DIRECTIONS TO WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY HORSE CENTER FROM AMARILLO, TX**

**\*\*Please Note: There are NO Dogs allowed on Horse Center Property\*\***

- From I-40 take exit # 70, south toward Canyon on I-27/US-87
- Head south on I-27 for 11 miles
- Take exit #110 onto Highway 87 south toward Canyon/ Hereford
- Exit onto Hunsley Road, which is the second exit
- Turn right on to access road (toward Wal-Mart) to the overpass
- Head east across the overpass and turn left onto the access road heading North
- WTAMU Horse Center is the first barn on the right hand side of the access road
- Enter at any gate and park on the North side of the main barn (which is the southern barn on the property)
