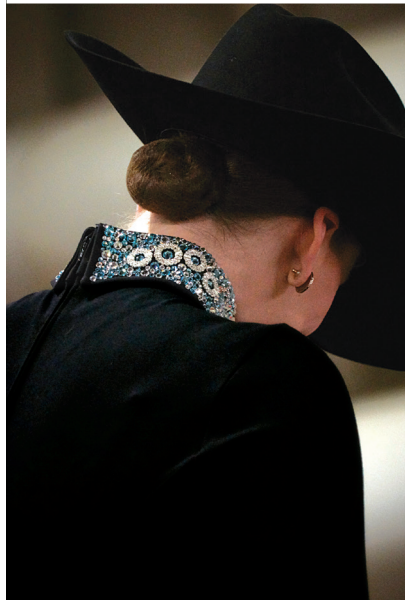
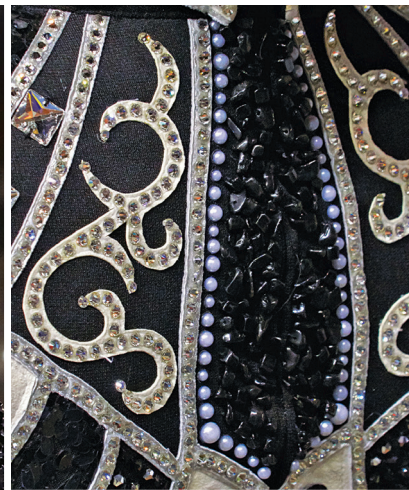
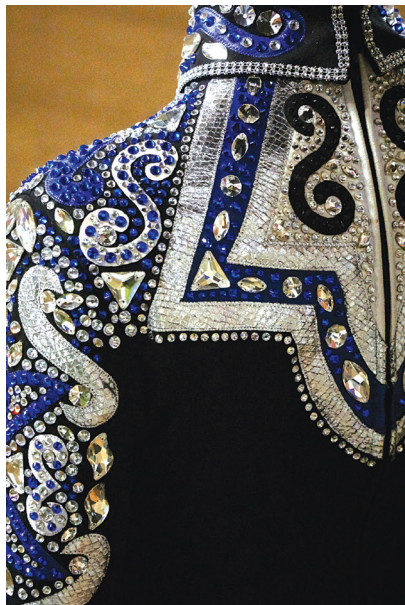


WESTERN SPARKLES

The Intercollegiate Horse Shows Association (IHSA) held its National Championship Horse Show at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, in May. Nearly 450 hunter seat and Western riders qualified from across the U.S. and Canada to compete in horsemanship, equitation, jumping, and reining. Riders drew and competed with horses, sight-unseen. The hunter-seat riders dressed conservatively, often subtly recognizing their schools by the uniformity of their apparel. The Western horsemanship riders were a treat for the eye.
